The Alabama Department of Environmental Management (ADEM or the Department) has reviewed the Alabama National Guard's (ANG) subject document. The Department concurs with the overall content of the subject document. The Department notes that additional remedial actions will be performed to support the ongoing Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study (RI/FS). At the conclusion of the RI/FS, a RI/FS Report including an Alabama Risk Based Corrective Action (ARBCA) Risk Assessment will be submitted to the Department for concurrence. Inclusion of all soil and groundwater data used in performing the Remedial Investigation must be included in the RI/FS Report for the Department's concurrence. Upon delineation of the TCE, the Department notes that source contamination of the soil will be excavated and in situ bioremediation will be conducted using existing wells.
