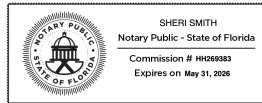

Organizational Maintenance Shop 28 (OMS 28) is an Alabama Army National Guard (ARNG) Field Maintenance Shop 28 located north of the Mobile Aeroplex at Brookley in Mobile, Alabama. The ARNG completed environmental studies, including soil and groundwater sampling, at OMS 28 due to the military vehicle and equipment maintenance operations conducted at the site, prepared a feasibility study to present and evaluate the remedial alternatives for site use, and prepared a proposed plan to identify the preferred remedial alternative.

The Department of Defense encourages community involvement in the environmental restoration process, and a Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) is one of many methods the ARNG may use to facilitate public participation at restoration sites. To keep the public informed and to provide opportunities for public involvement in its environmental restoration program, the ARNG is evaluating community interest in establishing a RAB, which would be made up of participants from the Army, Alabama Department of Environmental Management, and volunteer members of the local community. RABs provide a collaborative forum for the community, government agencies, and installation decision makers to discuss and identify the most efficient and productive means to restore the environment. RAB participants are not compensated and should be willing to attend all RAB meetings, which could last between two to four hours each and are held several times a year until the restoration activities are complete. Additionally, members must be willing to devote ample time to review documents within prescribed time frames.
